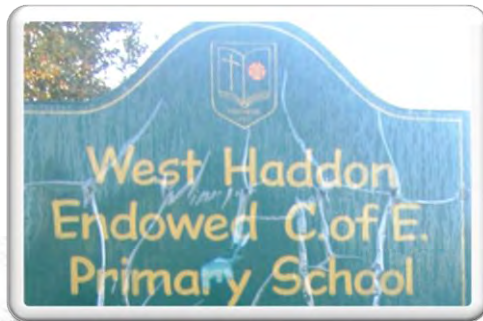
- We visited a nearby village, West Haddon, where our host school is situated.

- We always finished the day with a communal supper.



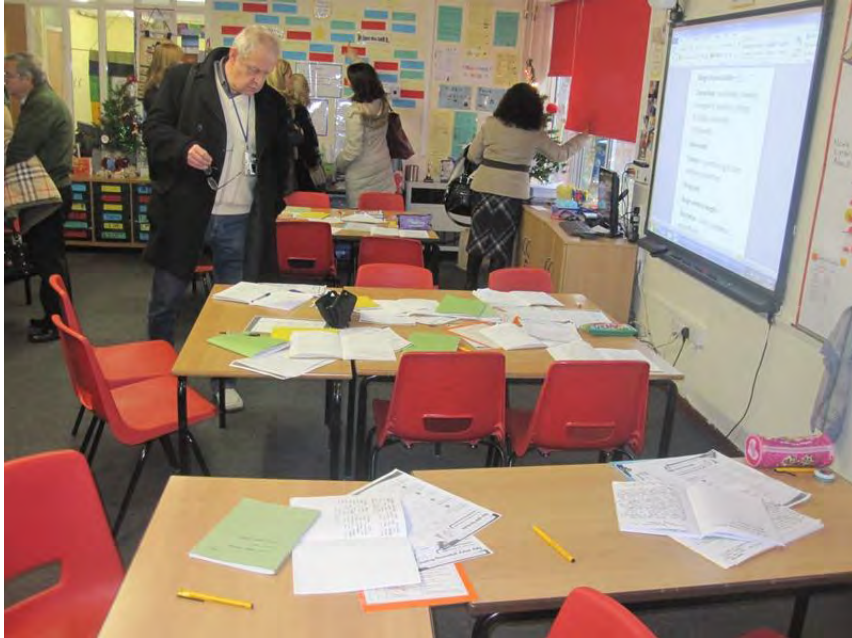

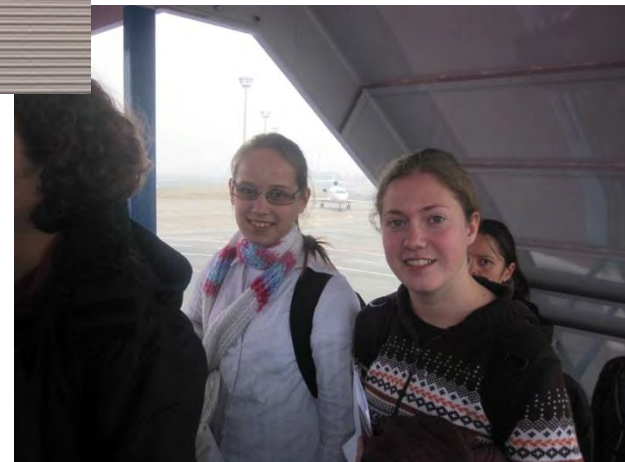
- At the end we looked round from the 58 meter high dome of the St. Paul cathedral.
